Strategically located in the heart of Wisconsin's growing region, BDLC is central to Chicago and the upper midwest.

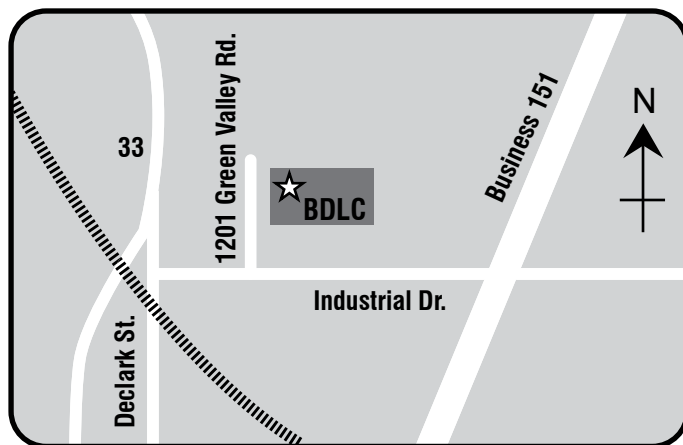
Location: Beaver Dam Logistic Center is located west of highway 151, just north of Beaver Dam
